Called on the avowed issue of supporting the striking members of the metal trades, who could not agree with two of three principal employers, the strike grew into a deadlock which finally defied the constituted authority of the government of Canada, and provoked rioting on the streets of Winnipeg, in which blood was freely shed and lives were lost. In its successive stages, the issues veered from the original ostensible purpose to the right of the police, firemen, postmen and other public employees engaged in maintaining vital public utilities to affiliate with a controlling labor body whose authority would supersede the oath of the individual to the Crown, then to the definition and general application of the principle of Collective Bargaining, afterwards to uncover the fact that some of the leaders, at least, of the...
